<u>New Forest Butterfly Transect Group – Week 2</u>

Another good week, 451 butterflies counted in total equating to 6.08 butterflies/km. This is far better than 2016 (2.73/km), even approaching the 2015 density of 6.14 butterflies /km for Week 2.

Most routes recorded more butterflies than in Week 1 and Breamore is already up to its old tricks with a count of 90 (10 different species)!
