- Sat Oct 3rd** **Hazel Hill, Nr East Grimstead.** (Privately Owned Site - In 2001 both Argent & Sable and Pearl-bordered Fritillary were recorded) 9.30am-4pm. Enter site at SU223285 and follow track to car parking area. Woodland ride management. Free lunch provided if booking received by 28/09/09. Joint event with Hazel Hill Volunteers
- Tues Oct 6th** **Bentley Wood, Nr West Tytherley** (Bentley Trust – this site is arguably the best butterfly site in the country!) 10am-4pm. Meet in main car park at SU258292, off Dean Road. Coppicing (training available to those new to coppicing).
- Sat Oct 17th** **Bentley Wood, Nr West Tytherley** (Bentley Trust) 10am-4pm. Meet in main car park at SU258292. Woodland management.
- Fri Oct 30th** **Winter Down Copse, Nr Little Somborne** (Privately Owned Site – one of the most important hazel coppice sites in the south of England with Pearl-bordered Fritillary, Duke of Burgundy, Grizzled Skipper and Common Fan-foot all still present) 10am-4pm. Meet on hard standing outside barn at SU389335. Hazel coppicing.
- Sat Nov 14th** **Winter Down Copse, Nr Little Somborne** (Privately Owned Site) 10am-4pm. Meet on hard standing outside barn at SU389335. Hazel coppicing.
